



Tuition Policies

- A one-time \$60.00 non-refundable fee will be charged to cover the enrollment costs.
- A deposit equivalent to one weeks tuition is due in advance and will be used toward the last week of your child's stay at Joyland (a two week notice must be provided in order for this to be applied)
- Tuition can be paid weekly, bi-weekly or monthly. Tuition for the month is due on the 1st day of the month, if paid monthly; on the 1st and 15th of each month, if paid bi-monthly; or the beginning of each week if paid weekly. Checks or credit cards are the forms of payment accepted.
- There is a 10% per month late charge fee on payments overdue more than two weeks. Payments that are overdue more than 30 days will be turned over to our financial representative.
- Each child will get one week of vacation at no cost, any time during a calendar year, starting 2 months after enrollment. A one week notice in writing is required. It only applies during the child's stay at Joyland, not upon withdrawal.
- **A TWO WEEK NOTICE IN WRITING MUST BE GIVEN FOR WITHDRAWAL.** At that time, the deposit will become effective and any adjustments, whether a balance or a credit, will be calculated.
- Due to many of our classrooms being full, any schedule changes **MUST** be approved by the director prior to the change being made.
- Tuition is due on legal holidays, including the week between Christmas and New Year and child's absence due to illness or other reasons. Missed days, such as holidays or sick days, may not be made up on other days. The same applies to center closings due to bad weather.
- There will be a \$40 charge on all returned checks.
- In case of default payment, the account will be referred to a collection agency.
- There will be a late fee pick up charge of \$1 per minute over 6:05 p.m.
- For families with more than one child, the oldest sibling will receive a 10% discount.
